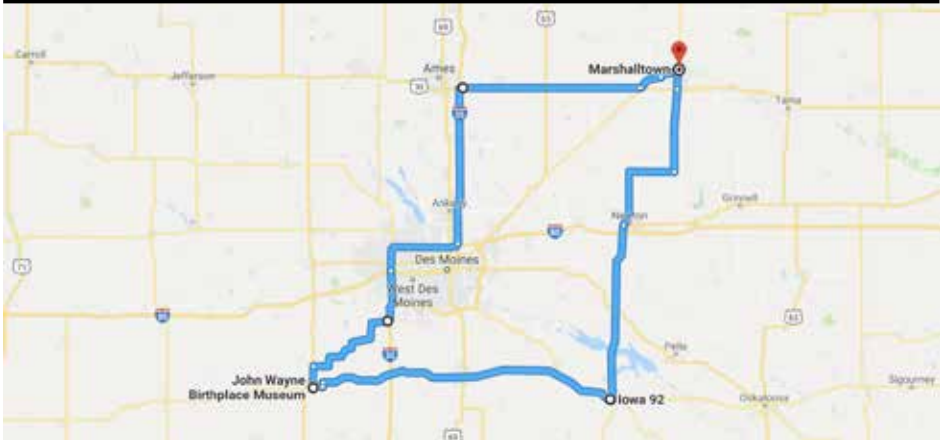

Six miles east of Marshalltown is Marshall and Three Bridges County Park, where you can take US-30 west towards Ames for a stop at Ledges State Park. Go south on I-35 until you reach Cumming Road. Ride south through the amazing valley to US-169 south which takes you to the John Wayne Birthplace Museum in Winterset. You can also explore the Covered Bridges of Madison County in that area. Head east on IA-5/92 to IA-14 north which takes you right back to Marshalltown.
